



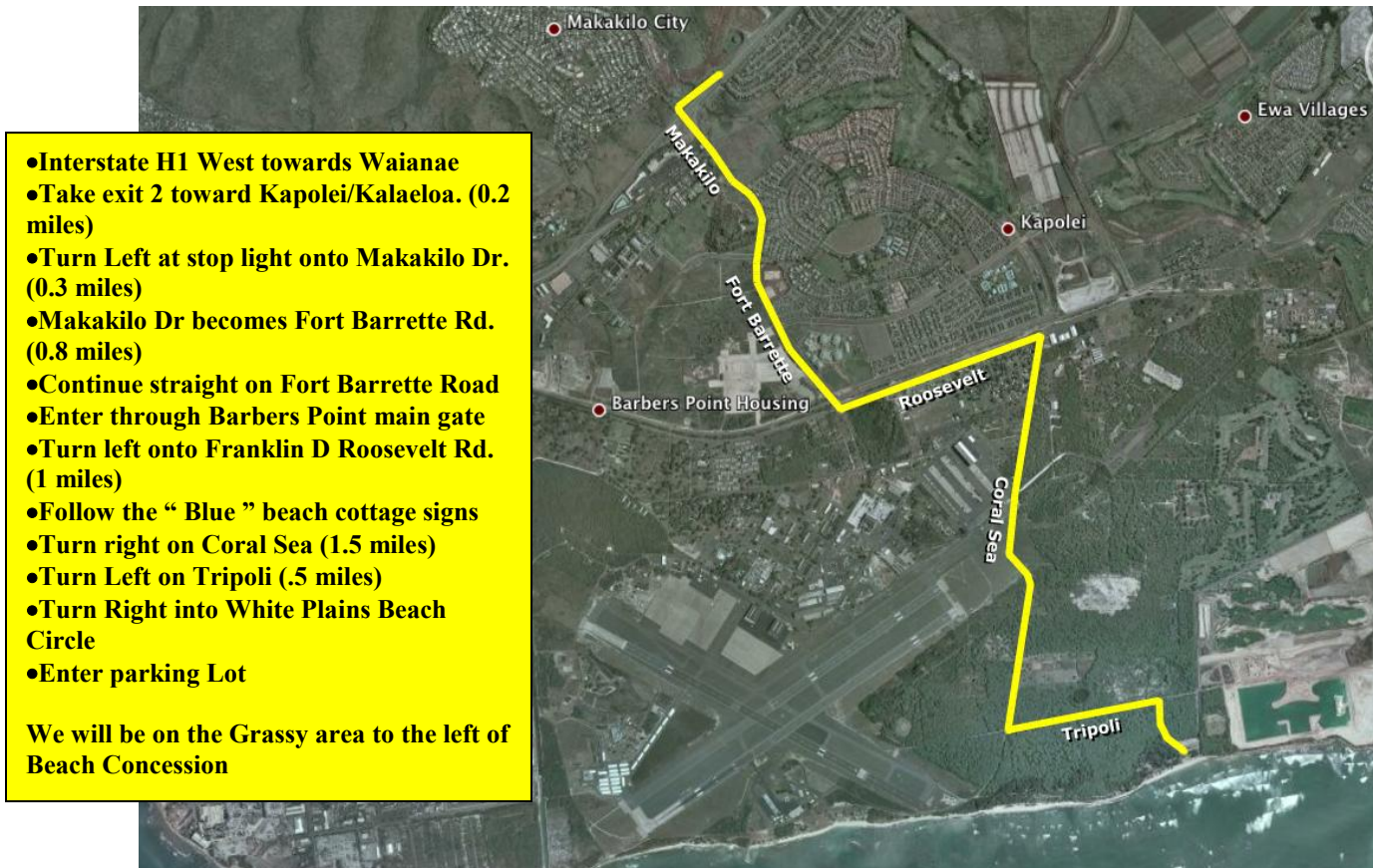
“Day at the Beach” Program

When/Where: First Saturday of each month from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. at White Plains Beach in Kalaeloa (see below for directions)

Who: AccessSurf is the only 501(c)3 nonprofit organization in Hawaii dedicated to empowering and helping children and adults with any type of disability to surf and swim in a safe and therapeutic environment with certified instructors and adaptive equipment.
