

- Advanced training for COVID-19 protocols


We hope to get back to as many of our regular programs as possible in 2021. From there we will evaluate the needs of our community to continue expand programs and outreach.








## **AccesSurf Demographics (2020)**





#### **2020 Programs**


## Number of program days with a total of 540 participant registrations and 1099 volunteer registrations (duplicated individuals)
